

REGULAR SESSION

October 11, 2016

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of McMinnville, Tennessee, met in regular session at its regular meeting place, City Hall, Tuesday, October 11, 2016, at approximately 6:00 p.m. Adequate public notice of the agenda and the change in the time of the meeting was given by notices posted at City Hall, notices in the Southern Standard newspaper and news reports on the local radio stations.
